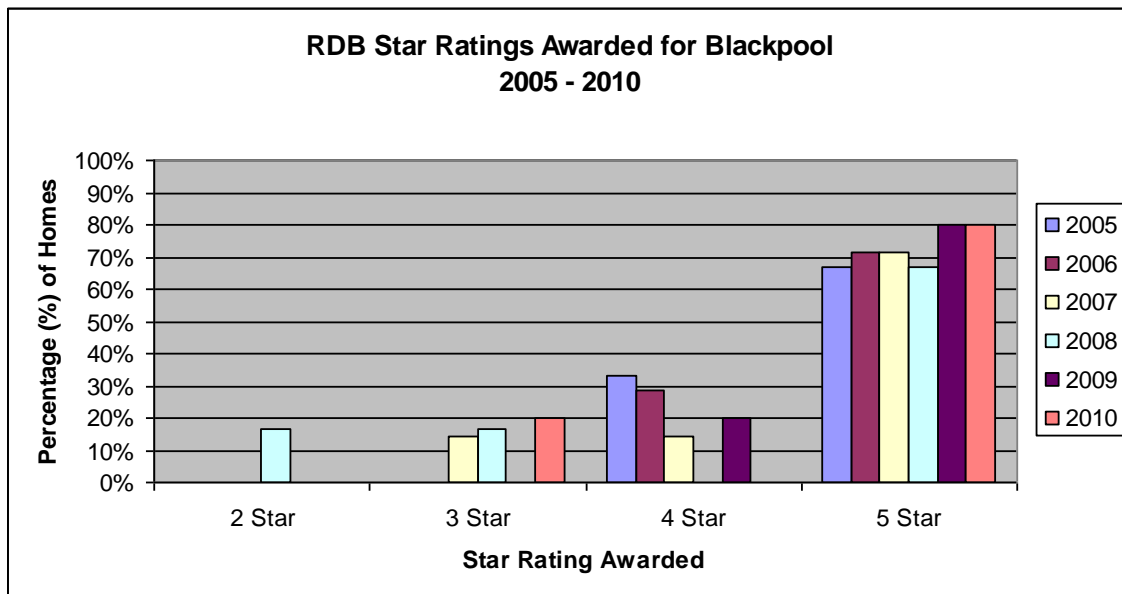
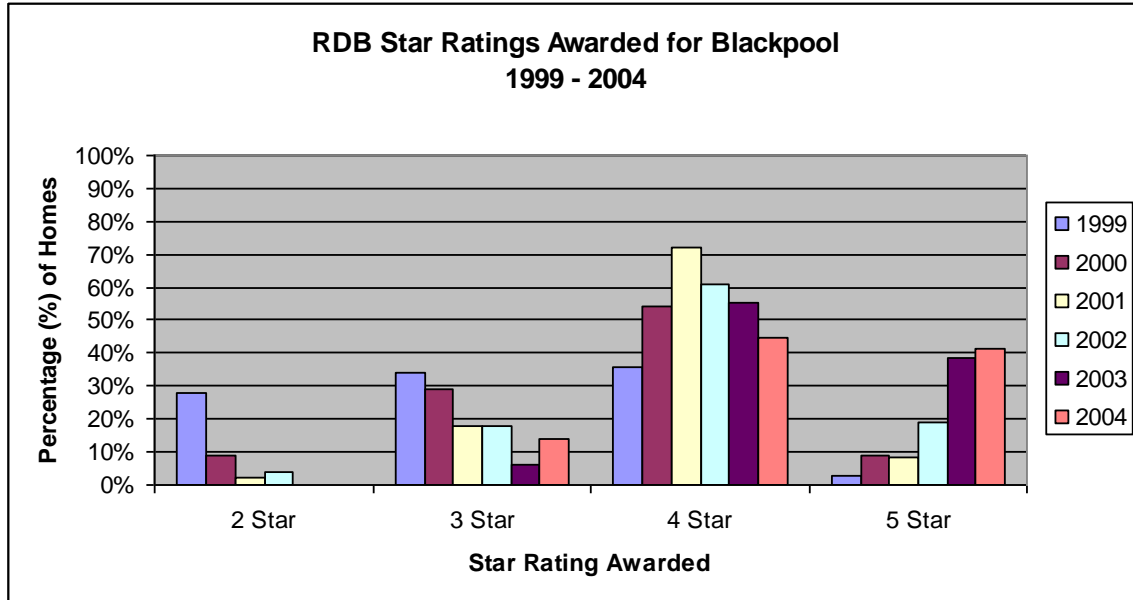


Historical Analysis of Participating Homes in Local Authority Areas

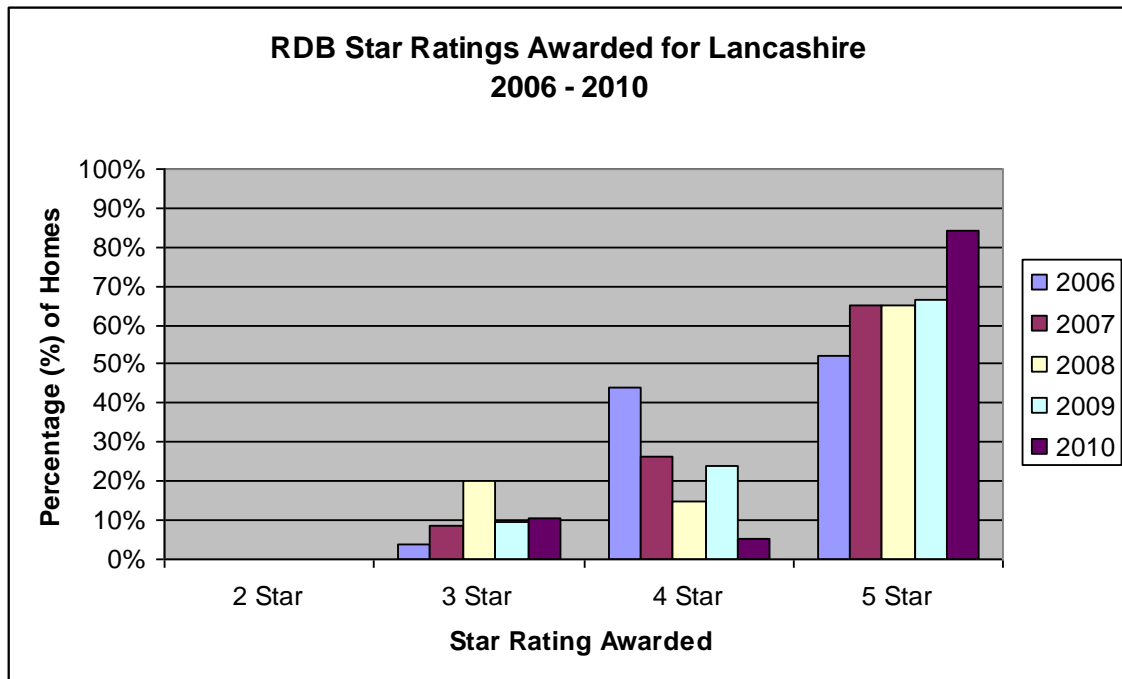
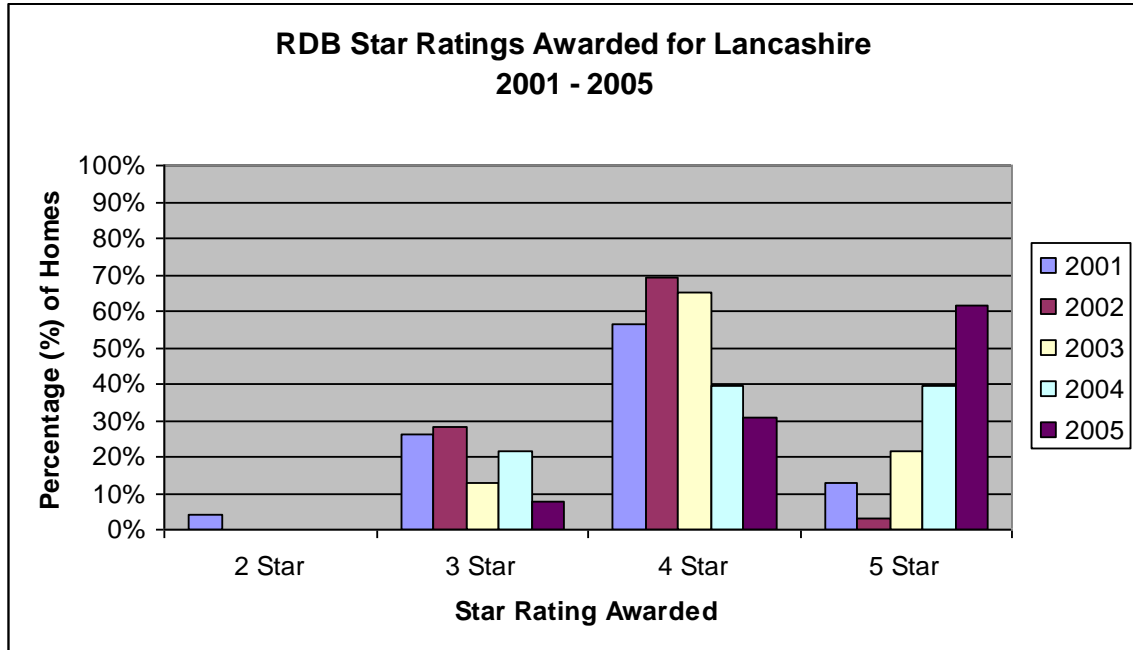
Blackpool

Blackpool was the first Local Authority to participate in the RDB Star Rating scheme back in 1999 and have just committed to do so again for the thirteenth successive year.



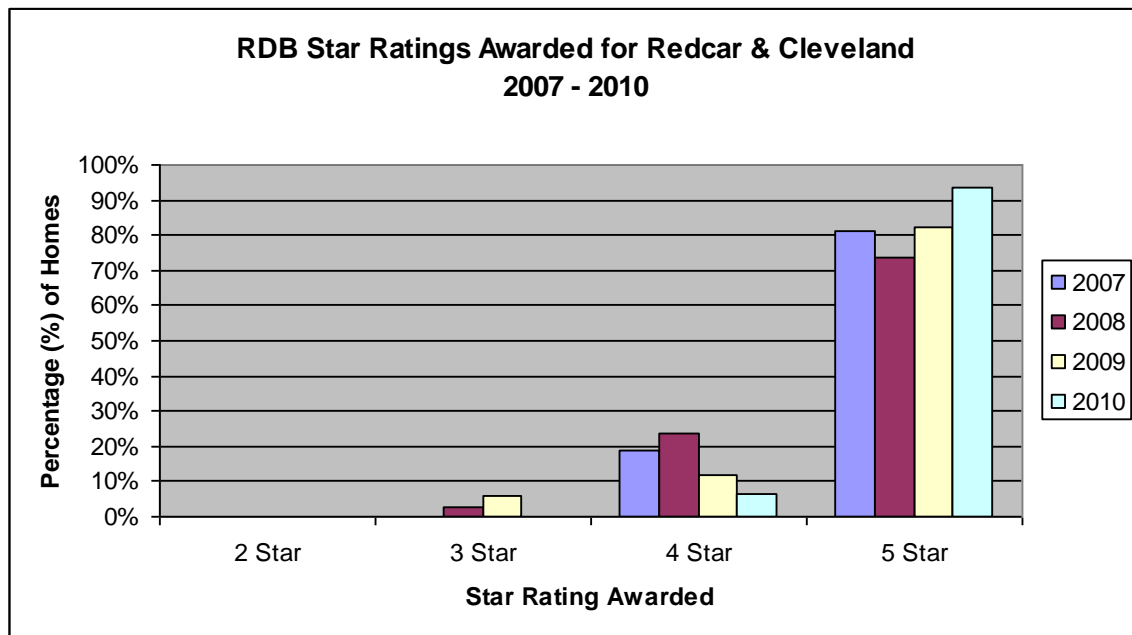
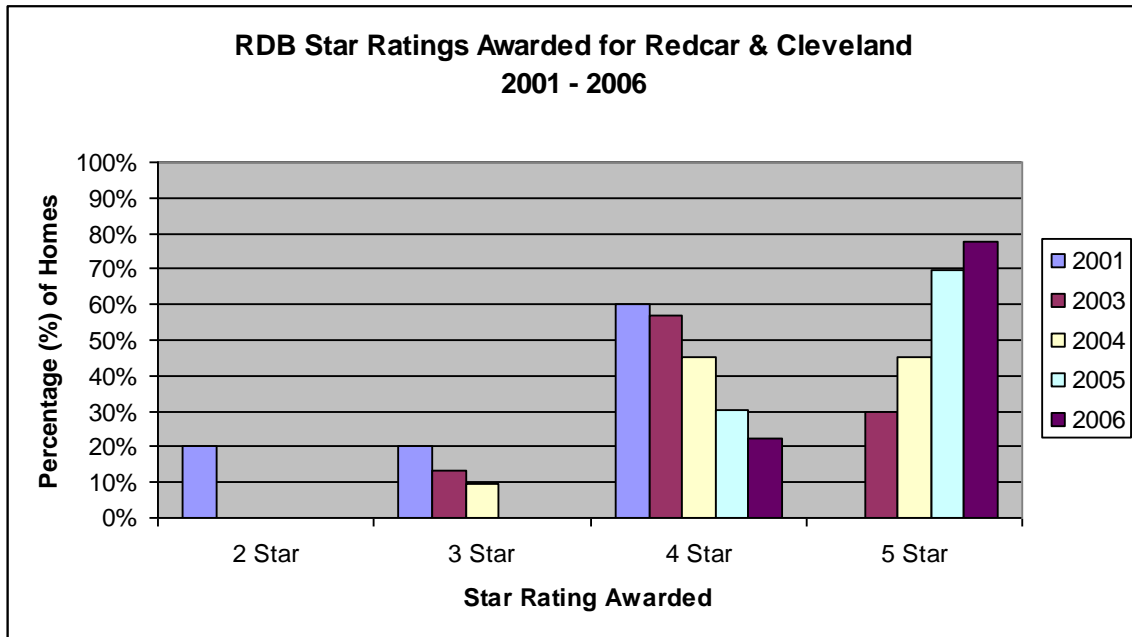
Lancashire

Since 2001, Lancashire Local Authority have been supporting the RDB Star Rating scheme and continue to do so today.



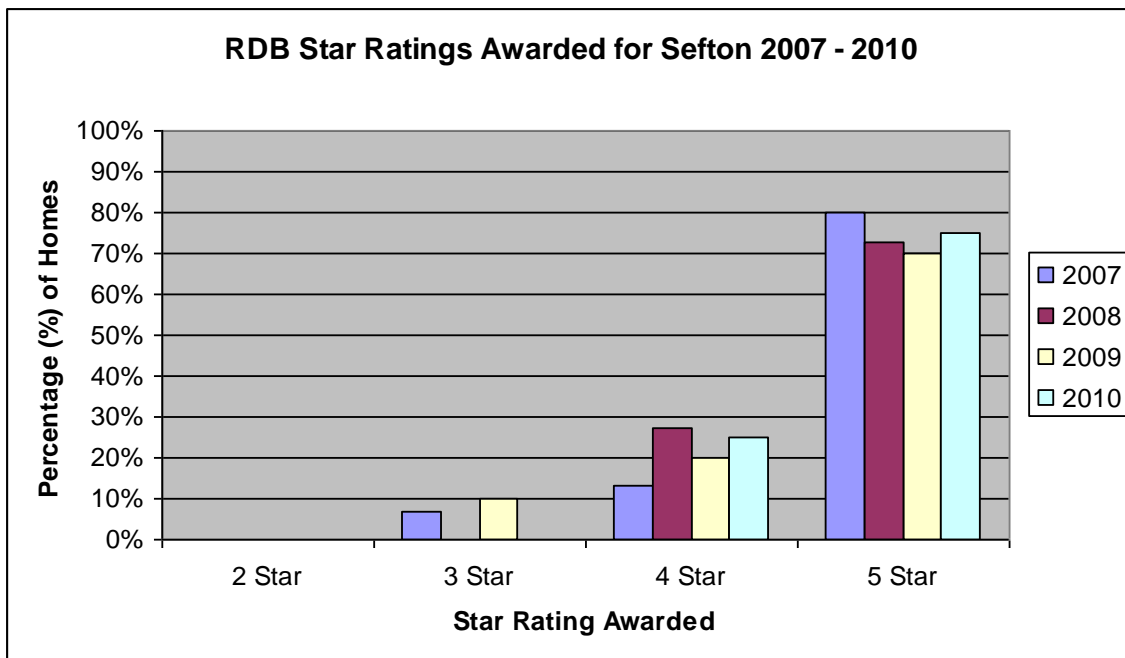
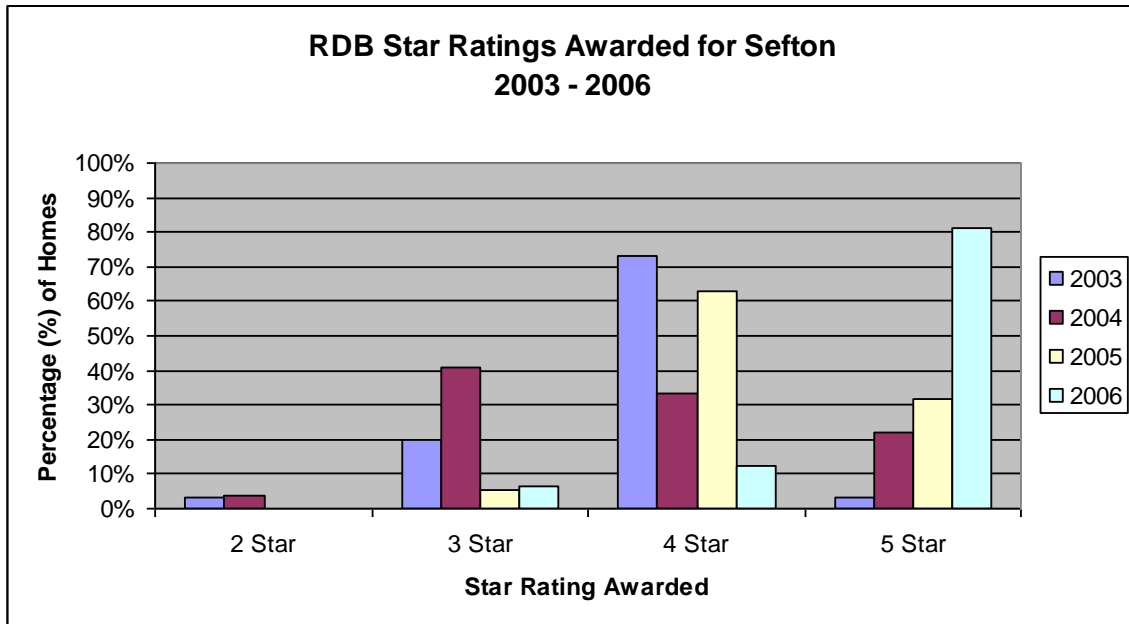
Redcar & Cleveland

Redcar & Cleveland Council have adopted the RDB Star Rating scheme since 2001 and are currently being accredited again this year.



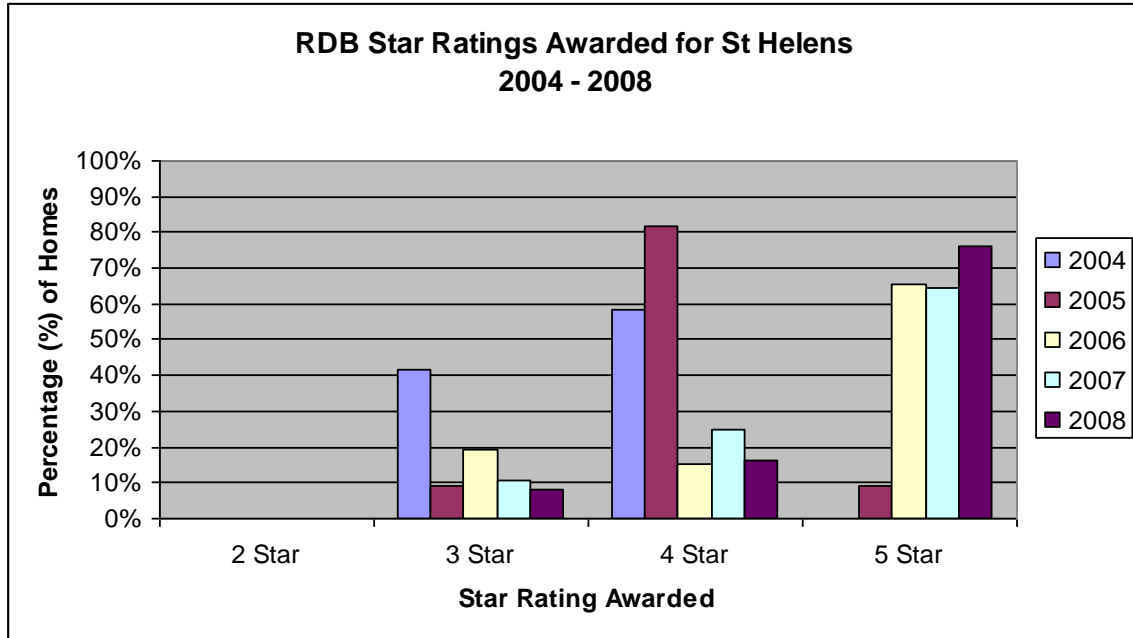
Sefton

Since 2003, care homes in Sefton have been given the opportunity to participate in the RDB Star Rating scheme and are now in their 9th year of accreditation.



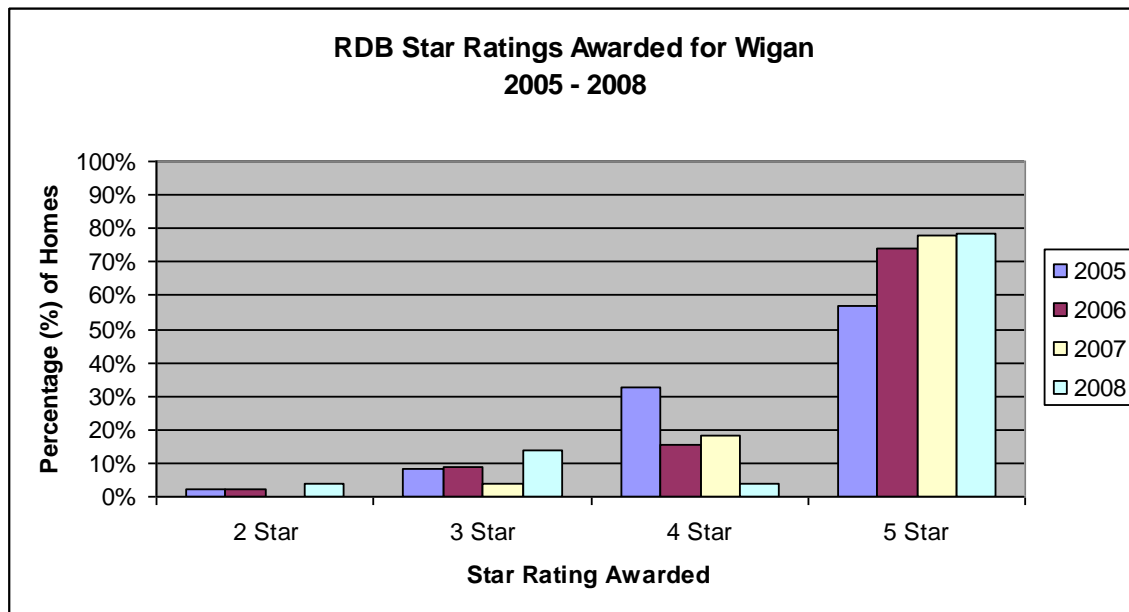
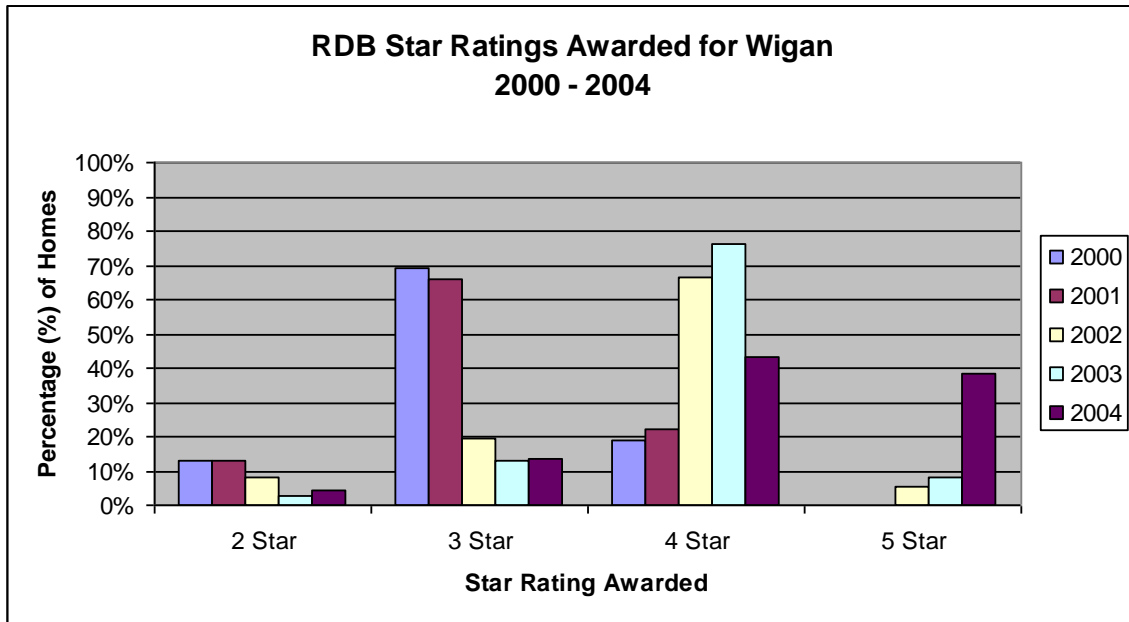
St Helens
